
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Multidisciplinary Art and Culture Hub & Co-Creation Space

The RedSapata association is a non-profit organization and is supported by art and culture funding from the City of Linz, the Province of Upper Austria and the Federal Chancellory. Movement artists, increasingly from a variety of disciplines, find here a place to work in the form of a rehearsal room, technical pool, information and presence platform, as well as a forum for exchange and networking.

During more than 10 years of activity, the association has developed conceptually and now works across and between disciplines. Since September 2021, the association's place of activity has been the "Sonnenstein LOFT" on the 4th floor of the former Art University Linz (Sonnensteinstraße 11 - 13, 4040 Linz).

In keeping with the artistic spirit of the building, art and culture live on here and unfold anew. Thanks to new spatial possibilities, the association was finally able to adapt its conception of content to recent developments and is now what it was always meant to be: a multidisciplinary art and culture center in the "Sonnenstein LOFT".





Sonnenstein LOFT -Room of possibilities



Sonnenstein LOFT is the new homebase of RedSapata, based on the experience and activity of the last 10 years of the RedSapata cultural initiative. Initially, it was a development project that started with the move in 2021 and now, since 2022, it has been unfolding its growth potential at the new location. With this growth should take place programs for art and culture that ideally establish, recur, improve and evolve. All this around the focus of the performing arts, first and foremost the art of movement and performance, with their intersections to all other art disciplines, especially to media art.

The Sonnenstein LOFT is therefore a community project, a co-creation space, a space that is adaptable to art and culture and connects the local with the international, the analog with the digital, the monodisciplinary with the multi-disciplinary.

In terms of content, the Sonnenstein LOFT means a space for experimental, performing art in connection with inter- and transdisciplinary creation, in particular taking place here:

Production Developments, Art Residencies, Exhibitions, Network Meetings, Digital Transmissions & Projects, Educational Programs, Art and Cultural Events, Performances & Presentations.

Interim Balance 2022 in words



According to the circumstances, 2022 is determined by a high degree of flexibility. We had a lot planned for the move to the new premises in 2021: the digitalization and conversion measures were to be completed, the workflows for the new location were to be defined in their sequence, and various processes were to be made digital.

Concerning the art projects, a focus on hybrid working was set, as it was already foreshadowed in 2021.

Due to the gain in work opportunities, meeting zones and technical infrastructure, more artists and consequently more audience were involved in what was happening, even beyond the national borders.

Ongoing activities / projects:

- Residencies / art production: daily, based on artists' requests/applications;
- Events / performances: on a case-by-case basis, 3-4 in-house events / showings / presentations per month;
- Documentaries & broadcasts: as part of live streaming studio, broadcast features > established as "Art Makers" in August 2022, two editions on view: https://dorftv.at/channel/dancetv-red-sapata-tanzfabrik
- Educational program: two semesters of curated courses: SS2022 March to May WS2022 October to December.

Special projects, collaborations & project tracks:

- Call 2021 / Hybrid Space: residencies & performances (international focus) on the theme of hybrid art / hybrid space;
- 10+10 Bridges: in cooperation with SOS-Menschenrechte -> from fall 2022 / promotion of integration through performing arts & music between locals and people with a refugee background;
- Support for children and youth: school projects with neighboring schools;
- Investments & resource building: by the end of 2022, spatial and structural investments should be completed;
- Hosting of two festivals in the contemporary movement arts and hybrid methods sector (international focus): Tanzhafen Festival Extended / Moments (Oct /Nov 2022), and A!KO Dance Festival.




Opening

Thanks to new spatial possibilities, the association can finally adapt its conceptual design to past developments and now becomes what it was always meant to be: a multidisciplinary art and cultural center within the "Sonnenstein LOFT", the new name for the floor at Sonnensteinstraße 11-13.

On October 22, 2021, the Sonnenstein Loft was officially opened. The large studio was used as a stage for the first time. The event was streamed live on Dorf TV and also represented the starting shot for live streaming technology.





Everyday life in Sonnenstein LOFT

Every day, different activities are run at Sonnenstein LOFT.

Residency artists are given the opportunity to rehearse every day, and they have both a studio stage with technical equipment and technical assistance at their disposal, which is especially beneficial for hybrid projects.

Three times a week, there is morning dance training for professionals, which is a sign of regular attendance of professional dancers, as well as their affiliation to the RedSapata association.

RedSapata members are given daily two dance studios at their disposal, free of charge, for rehearsals and project development.

In the Community Space there are opportunities for co-working and meetings, where ideas are exchanged and the administrative work of the association takes place.

Evening classes are held daily, a time when the external audience visits the association for educational purposes.

Evening events are organized regularly, including Sunday Showings, where unfinished works find their moment.

Focus Project: Hybrid Space

#interdisciplinary art research #digital vs. analog #hybrid spaces of art making

Hybrid Space is a technical resource and above all a place, an experimental field for interdisciplinary exploration of digital possibilities in analog space with a focus on dance, movement and performance. Multiple cameras, software and hardware enable live broadcasts on a technically flawless level. For July - August 2022, 3 residencies for professional artists were granted, in which scenarios of use were developed and hybrid art-making was brought into focus.

In 2020, the global pandemic has popularized the word "hybrid" in the creative and cultural industries. Cultural festivals, visual artists, performers and theaters were hooked on hybridity. RedSapata picked up on this social and artistic development and designed the "Hybrid Space Project". The "Call 2021" was intended to promote digital projects, take up relevant topics and focus on new formats of artistic production, communication and the transfer of knowledge and culture with the recipients. The spectrum included art and cultural projects, digital strategies, artificial intelligence, apps, games, digital platforms and interactive websites, virtual and augmented reality, etc.

60 artists and collectives from 20 nations participated in the call. Eva-Maria Kraft (AT), Tomo Sone (JAP) and Lorenzo Morandini (IT) were able to convince with their submitted works on hybrid forms of presentation in dance and performance. The selection was curated by Cornelia Lehner, cultural manager and dance educator. During the summer months of July and August it was then possible to offer these three selected inter/national professional dance makers a space for research and development of new creations. On 13.10.2022 the artists presented their works, and their work in progress.

"ARTIFICIAL BODIES in a POETIC SPACE"

Concept, Choreography, Dance: Eva-Maria Kraft; Composition, Live-Music: Rupert Huber

The performance "ARTIFICIAL BODIES in a POETIC SPACE" was developed in the context of a 3-week residency in "hybrid space" and shows in its first sequences the newly developed hybrid performance practice. Based on the performance format POETIC SPACE developed by Eva-Maria Kraft and Rupert Huber, the hybrid extension also makes visible on several levels the dialogue emerging in the moment between the media of dance and music and the simultaneous communication with space as a shaping element in live performance: real and digitally imaged bodies, phygital bodies and data bodies, which form a non/human language of movement, meet live electronic music played from digital sound generators and the digital transmission of further real spaces. These correlate with the streamed reality that can be experienced in space, interweave and intertwine and merge into a whole in the live performance.

My research began at Sonnenstein Loft as a 2-week residency within the project Hybrid Space, in those days I focused my research on the possibilities that drones have to inhabit the space with their movement and how their paths can relate to the dancing body. The research led to a first study of coexistence of the human body and the machine. The results were surprising with a wide range of possible developments; the research went on with further residencies where I explored on a deeper level this dynamic relation that can evolve both to a geometric drawing of pure lines and a more expressive outcome based on the concept of two humans relating to each other thanks to the medium of the quatricopters.

The artists have a 1-2 week period to work on their projects. The framework is completely free - it can be a research without focus on results, or a fully realized stage production. The format of a show can also vary depending on the project. Our goal for 2023 is to give the residency artists a regular occasion to share their work and/or process with the audience. This is possible, for example, in the context of Sunday Showings - an event in which there is an exchange performeraudience after a show performed in a very relaxed atmosphere, which can inspire and enrich both sides.





Sunday performances give passionate dance enthusiasts the opportunity to get a behind-the-scenes look at professional dance artists. The aim is to generate an audience and to mediate; for the artists, it opens the possibility to receive feedback.

During the day, artists offer workshops in which they share their artistic methods with interested participants. In the evening, they present their current projects in an atmospheric setting. Afterwards there is the possibility for both sides - the audience as well as the performers - to exchange ideas and discuss art topics.

So far, 5 Sunday Showings evenings have been planned, 2 of which have been realized due to Corona-related cancellation obligations (Lockdown in the fall of 2021 or Corona cases among the artists in 2022).



University of Artistic Design Linz - summer workshop by media artist Chris Ziegler with master's students from the Interface Cultures Department and Anton Bruckner Private University/Institute of Dance Art, supported by the RedSapata Cultural Initiative.

On September 7th and 8th, Chis Ziegler presented interactive performances and installations developed during a two-month summer workshop as a part of the Ars Electronica Festival. The workshop took place in an interactive robotic stage with about 30 powered LEDs and explored the relationship between human movement and a mechanized environment. "How can we make the user or audience experience more physical and participatory? A dancer's body is connected to the environment and interacts with both the audience and the mechanical system through digital interfaces. How does movement on a robotic stage change orientation and relationship to the human body? What is the experience of immersion in a digital and mechanical universe?"

The research was supported by the NATIONAL PERFORMANCE NETWORK - STEPPING OUT, funded by the Federal Government Commissioner for Culture and the Media under the NEUSTART KULTUR. Dance funding program.

Chris Ziegler is a director, performer and artist working in the performing and digital arts with training in architecture and new media arts. After teaching "Interactive Media" at Arizona State University (USA) 2013 - 2021, he is a member of DOCKdigital Motiontracking Lab Berlin. He is working again on dance and theater productions with VR, AR and AI, supported by VW Cultura Foundation, German National Perfoming Arts Fund and others.

#youth artists in focus #promotion of young talents

TANZCLUB is a development format for dance productions that enables a team of young artists to continuously work creatively and to further develop the outcomes. The important thing here is to establish a regular format for joint training, joint exploration and joint development in order to close an existing gap in the area of promoting young artists and at the same time to enable qualitative, artistic work by professional dance artists.

Tanzclub was conceived as a project of RedSapata Tanzfabrik as a response to an existing demand for individual dance education in combination with local possibilities and opportunities. New or uncommon places in Linz and Upper Austria are to be played/danced in the same way as local renowned stages.

The following thematic blocks are the goal of our artistic implementation:

- Space Design between Body & Object / Audiospace
- Invisible Structures psycho-motoric connections
- Mass Collectives the movement of the mass in the context of social politics and/or where is the mass in the lockdown
- Walking Borders a border crossing between movement research, expression and impression, overlapping disciplines
- Immersive audience formats in urban space

The CID is the official umbrella organization for all forms of dance in all countries of the world. The council is a non-profit international non-governmental organization, founded in 1973 within the UNESCO headquarters in Paris, where it is also based. Members are major federations, associations, schools, groups and individuals in more than 170 countries. CID works with national and local governments, international organizations, and institutions as an official UNESCO partner. The Vienna Section (headed by Rose Breuss) has recently emerged from this Council under whose auspices this event is held.

On two evenings of performances so far, more than 10 dance productions have been presented, showcasing the diversity and virtuosity of contemporary dance art with the participation of international professionals.

It was the second event evening of the Viennese CID Section since its foundation and this time it took place again in the Sonnenstein LOFT. On board were artists who either have a connection with the Anton Bruckner Private University or are dancers of the Landestheater Linz, in addition to other international freelance solo artists or ensembles. A colorful mix of impressive choreographic signatures was on display. The contributions were 5-20 minutes long, so the audience also had the opportunity to take a look at various performances and get a diverse picture of international contemporary dance.

School Project Street Dance "Foreign Cultures Fused"

The workshop series "Streetdance - Foreign Cultures Fused", which took place within the framework of Culture Connect, taught students of the Stifter Gymnasium Linz about street dance culture and its origins. From popping to hip-hop, the workshops included the basic steps of the various dance styles. In the period from April to July, the workshops took place on 5 dates with 2 units each.

In the course of the workshop series, the students learned the basic elements of the street dance style, as well as learned and danced a choreography with the basic steps. This promoted the body awareness of the participants and the feeling of belonging to the group.

Another focus of the workshops was also to emphasize the different cultural influences that fall under street dance. Through the meeting of different cultures and different people, parties and dances were created, which emphasize the inclusion and diversity of the people and stand under the principle "Love, Peace and Unity". These contents should be internalized by the students in the course of the workshops, in order to create a non-judgmental dance learning environment.
